The First International Conference on Media and Information Literacy and Global Understanding, held in Cairo in 2024, was a groundbreaking gathering organized by the Arab Academy for Science, Technology and Maritime Transport (Egypt) and the Autonomous University of Barcelona (Spain), under the auspices of the League of Arab States and UNESCO's MILID Network.

Bringing together over 250 policymakers, experts, and thought leaders, the conference fostered a powerful consensus on the critical role of Media and Information Literacy (MIL) and intercultural dialogue (MILID) in advancing global peace. The discussions and insights shared laid the foundation for stronger international cooperation and innovative strategies to empower societies through MIL.
